Application Deadlines

The priority and fellowship deadline for M.S. students will be February 1st, with applications being considered on a rolling basis after that date.

Ph.D. applications must be submitted in their entirety by February 1st.

All required materials listed above must be received by the published deadlines.

Where is your campus located?

Our campus is nestled directly in the heart of Midtown Atlanta, one of America's largest and most thriving cities.

Is the M.S. in Economics a full-time program?

In order to complete the program in one calendar year, students must be a enrolled full-time (twelve credit hours in both the fall and spring semesters) and six credit hours during the summer semester.

Can I be enrolled and complete the program on a part-time basis?

Students who wish to complete the program as a part-time student may do so.

Do I have to specialize in a specific field?

No, there is a high degree of flexibility that allows students to craft their own areas of specialization through both Economics and non-Economics course offerings.
